Knitting and Crocheting Rules and Instructions

- a) Exhibitors and their families are responsible for reading and complying with the Junior Fair General Rules & Instructions.
- b) Fair association is not responsible for articles lost/stolen.
- c) No hangers please.
- d) A pair constitutes one article; do not have to be identical.
- e) All exhibits should be made with a crocheting hook or knitting needles, unless specified to be made without.
- f) Posters can be no larger than 14"x22", and displays can be no larger than 28"x40".
- g) All entries MUST be accompanied by a 3"x5" card which includes information listed below. Should be typed or printed.
 1. Fiber content of yarn(s) – state percentage(s)
 2. Intended use (who will use it)
 3. Intended care
 4. Size of needles or hooks used
 5. Exhibitor's age
 6. Number of years in project
 7. Gauge used

CLASS A – KNITTING, Gr. 3-6
