Judging – Monday, July 18, 2022 @ 9:30 am –Exhibition Hall

- ❖ FairEntry Registration is June 1, 2022 to June 30, 2022
- ❖ \$22 entry fee per exhibitor
- ❖ Non-perishable Articles must be check into Exhibition Hall Saturday, July 16, 2022 between 8:00 am – Noon.
- ❖ Perishable articles must be check into Exhibition Hall Monday, July 18, 2022 between 8 am – 9 am.
- ❖ Articles must remain on display until 6:00 pm Sunday.
- ❖ Foods will be judged on appearance as well as appropriateness of method. (Check with UW-Cooperative Extension Service Green County Office for correct methods.)
- ❖ Only foods canned since August 1 of last year may be entered.
- ❖ Exhibits are to be in standard pint or quart jars. All jams, jellies and preserves should be in a standard jelly jar.
- ❖ All jams, jellies, and preserves will be opened for judging.
- ❖ Each jar must be labeled as follows:

- ❖ One entry allowed per lot.

### CLASS B – VEGETABLES

## CLASS C – ASSORTMENTS

Premiums \$1.75 \$1.50 \$1.25 \$1.00

### Lot

1. Canned meat, assorted – 3 jars
2. Jam, assorted – 3 jars
3. Jelly, assorted – 3 jars
4. Preserves, assorted – 3 jars
5. Group of 3 jars (meat, vegetable, fruit) which could be used for a family meal. Must include a menu for the meal.

## CLASS D – PICKLES

Premiums \$1.75 \$1.50 \$1.25 \$1.00

### Lot

1. Pickled beets
2. Pickled crab apples
3. Dill pickles
4. Sweet pickle
5. Relish – any kind
6. Any other pickle (not fitting in above lot)

## Rules for Classes E,F,G

Premiums \$1.75 \$1.50 \$1.25 \$1.00

- ❖ Baked goods must be checked in at Exhibition Hall between 8-9 am Monday morning. The entries in these classes will be judged and then only the judge's sample will be kept for display. The rest of the product will either need to be taken home or disposed of.

## CLASS E- YEAST BREAD & ROLLS

*(must be submitted in a zip lock bag)*

### Lot

1. White Bread- 1 loaf
2. Yeast Rolls – one dozen +1 roll for judging
3. Yeast Cinnamon Rolls – 6 unfrosted + 1 roll for judging
4. Any other bread- 1 loaf

## CLASS F- DESSERTS

*(submitted on a disposable pan or paper plate in zip lock bag)*

### Lot

1. Cookies, any kind labeled- one dozen +1 cookie for judging
2. Pound Cake loaf labeled
3. Decorated Cupcakes, 6 any kind- decorated (judged on decoration only but must be edible)
4. Coffee Cake

## CLASS G- PIES

*(no eggs, no milk, 9" foil pan in zip lock bag)*

### Lot

1. Apple Pie
2. Cherry Pie
3. Peach Pie
4. Other Fruit Pie (must be labeled)
