Rules and Instructions
(Grades K-2 Only)
All Lots Face-to-Face

- a) Exhibitors and their families are responsible for reading and complying with the Junior Fair General Rules & Instructions.
- b) Fair Association is not responsible for articles lost/stolen during fair.
- c) Exhibitors are responsible for securing to the display or exhibit all loose pieces of the entry (i.e. wire, zip ties, string, or glue).
- d) **All models should be mounted on a base or platform no larger than 18"x18"**.
- e) Posters must be no larger than 14"x22" and have a title. Displays must be no larger than 28"x40".
- f) Pictures can be cutouts, drawings, or photos.
- g) Pictures should be glued on to a poster or mat with rubber cement and be labeled.
- h) No real food or live animals are to be exhibited.
- i) Put name, age, club, class, and lot number on back side of every entry.
- j) Participants receive ribbons **ONLY**.
- k) **Members can enter up to 4 lots.**
- l) Projects can be brought in from Noon to 6:30 p.m. on Tuesday. Judging begins at 12 noon and goes until 6:30 pm. All projects will be judged one-on-one individually with the member when they arrive.
- m) Projects are released at 6:00 p.m. on Sunday.

CLASS A – ANIMAL SCIENCE

Lot

1. Create a critter (i.e. puppet, clay, recycled items)
2. A homemade toy or treat for my pet(s)
3. Scrapbook or memory book about my pet
4. Bird feeder
5. Bird house
6. Craft that is animal related
7. Any other pet/animal exhibit (No Live Animals)

CLASS B – ARTS & COMMUNICATION

Lot

1. Musical instrument made by exhibitor
2. Scrapbook of photos done by member (with captions/journaling)
3. T-shirt decorated by exhibitor (on hanger)
4. Small wood item
5. Any craft item
6. Item of art from a kit (i.e. paint by number, scratch art, etc.)

CLASS C – HOME ECONOMICS

Lot

1. My Family Tree (poster, scrapbook, etc.)
2. Small silk flower arrangement done by exhibitor
3. Display or poster about the food groups (i.e. Dairy Products)
4. Any sewing or stitchery item
5. Craft item for the home (kits can be used)
6. Home décor item (i.e. ceramics)
7. "I want to be a chef!" (Do a display or exhibit about a menu you helped plan).
8. Any other Family, Home or Health-related poster or display not mentioned above

CLASS D – MECHANICAL SCIENCE/AEROSPACE

Lot

1. A simple woodworking exhibit
2. Homemade kite
3. Model of electrical circuit
4. Snap together model kit (i.e. Legos, Erector, K'nex)
5. Small model airplane or rocket (not a kit)
6. Any other mechanical science or electricity-related exhibit

CLASS E – NATURAL SCIENCES

Lot

1. A poster or scrapbook about a family outdoor adventure (i.e. hiking, camping, canoeing)
2. Display of 5 insects (labeled)
3. Nature mobile
4. Craft made of recycled materials
5. Exhibit about trees (i.e. Leaf collection, bark rubbings)
6. Exhibit about wildlife in your backyard
7. Display of mineral/fossil collection
8. Any other natural resources exhibit

CLASS H – SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY

Lot

1. Simple rain/snow gauge made by exhibitor
2. Scrapbook or book about weather
3. Display or poster about space
4. Chemistry Exhibit (i.e. homemade Gak, Homemade Play Dough, etc.)
5. Display or exhibit of "Something I made on the computer"
6. Any other science or technology-related exhibit

CLASS F – PERSONAL GROWTH & DEVELOPMENT

Lot

1. Book or scrapbook all about me
2. Poster or Scrapbook of adult community workers with photos, journaling, and/or autographs (minimum of 5, maximum of 10; i.e. sales clerks, banker, post office worker, hospital worker, etc.)
3. Exhibit about something I did for the first time this year (i.e. swim, skateboard, cook, roller skate, drive go-cart, etc.)
4. Poster on how I volunteered or helped out in my community this year
5. Any other related exhibit or poster

CLASS G – PLANTS AND SOIL SCIENCE

Lot

1. Plant grown from a seed
2. Potted house plant grown by member
3. A picture made from seeds
4. Dish garden (uncovered garden of plants)
5. A poster or scrapbook about how I help in the garden
6. A collection of 3 vegetables I helped grow
7. Any other related plant and soil science exhibit
