Woodworking Rules and Instructions

- a) Exhibitors and their families are responsible for reading and complying with the Junior Fair General Rules & Instructions.
- b) Fair Association is not responsible for articles lost/stolen during fair.
- c) All exhibitors are encouraged to be present for judging.
- d) Member must exhibit in Unit in which they are enrolled, including shop class entries.
- e) Exhibitors must exhibit in their grade division. Limit of 4 entries per exhibitor and no more than 1 entry per lot number.
- f) Work must have been made since September 1 of last year.
- g) All articles are to be finished according to their intended use. The quality of the finish will be considered as part of the workmanship in judging.
- h) An article made for class work and for a grade or extra credit must be entered in the class so designated.
- i) No kits or mass production items to be used, except in specified lots.
- j) Members may wish to attach a card explaining an exhibit.
- k) Hangable projects must have applicable hangers for their intended use.
- l) Posters must be no larger than 14"x22", and displays must be no larger than 28"x40", unless otherwise stated.
