Exhibitors and their families are responsible for reading and complying with the Junior Fair General Rules & Instructions.

Dog Rules and Instructions

- A. Green County 4-H Dog Project rules will apply.
- B. Youth interested in participating in any of the Junior Fair Dog Shows should be aware of the following eligibility requirements:
 - a. **Submit a [Dog Project Health Form](#)**, (vaccinations and negative fecal and external parasites tests)
 - For Dog Agility, bring to first Dog Agility practice that you attend.
 - For Dog Obedience/Showmanship, due to the Extension office by June 12th.

 - b. **Submit a [Dog Obedience Form](#)**, as documentation that youth participant and dog have completed together an obedience training program (minimum of 6 face-to-face sessions, with other dogs present) during the current or previous years (past 4-H obedience training will count, but puppy socializing classes will not count). Obedience training programs can be taught by a club's 4-H Dog Leader or a professional trainer.
 - For Dog Agility, bring to first Dog Agility practice that you attend.
 - For Dog Obedience/Showmanship, due to the Extension office by June 12th.

- c. Youth must be able to handle and walk dog obediently on leash without parental or adult assistance. Please note that superintendents and judges reserve the right to dismiss a dog from the show if they feel the exhibitor is not able to handle the dog or poses a danger.
 - d. A dog that has attained a qualifying score at a county fair dog show must advance to the next higher class the following year. If you don't get a qualifying score, you do not have to advance. If you are a returning participant and uncertain of whether or not you received a qualifying score last year, please contact the Extension Green County Office at 608-328-9440.
 - e. No dog may be shown by more than one handler or in more than one obedience class.
 - f. Agility participants must have participated in at least one (1) 4-H Dog Agility practice.
 - g. Each dog must be equipped with a slip or buckle collar with no attachments (no name tags, rabies tags or license, etc.) and a 6-foot leather or nylon leash. Pinch collars, Halti's (head collar), chain leashes, electric training collars, and harnesses will not be allowed.
- C. Entering your dog in the correct lot is critical! Please see Junior Fair General Rules. Animals incorrectly entered will not receive fair premium and will not be eligible for awards.

Heel on leash and figure 8
Long sit (one minute)
Stand for examination
Long down (3 minutes)
Recall and Finish
3. **Pre-Novice B**
Heel on leash and figure 8
Long sit (one minute)
Stand for examination
Long down (3 minutes)
Recall and Finish
4. **Novice**
Heel on leash and figure 8
Long sit (one minute)
Stand for examination
Long down (3 minutes)
Heel free includes figure 8
Recall and Finish
5. **Graduate Novice**
Heel on leash (no figure 8)
Drop on recall
Stand for examination
Long sit (3 minutes)
Heel free includes figure 8
Long down (5 minutes)
6. **Pre-Open**
Heel free and figure 8
Broad Jump
Drop on recall
Long sit and down
Retrieve on flat
7. **Open**
Heel free
Retrieve over high jump
Figure 8 free
Broad jump
Drop on recall
Long sit and down
Retrieve on flat

CLASS B – SHOWMANSHIP (Danish Judging)

Exhibitors must enter this lot on their fair entry form in order to compete.

10. Showmanship, Grades 3-6
11. Showmanship, Grades 7 & Up

CLASS C – DOG AGILITY

Premiums: \$ 4.50 \$ 3.50 \$ 2.50 \$ 1.50

Two runs per member except JTT A that hasn't qualified to novice or above in obedience. Each member can do a JTT and Standard course with the previously stated exception.

Dogs 5 years and older are allowed to run one height lower than normal.

Lot - CLASS C – DOG AGILITY

15. **JTT A** (Jumps, Tunnels, Table) 1 yr in obedience with control of animal – on leash
16. **JTT B** (Jumps, Tunnels, Table) Advanced from JTT A – on or off leash
17. **Advanced JTT** – off leash, qualified in JTT B off leash
18. **Standard A** (regular course) – on leash – 1st time agility – must have qualified for Novice
19. **Standard B** (regular course with more equipment) – on or off leash, previously qualified in Standard A
20. **Advanced Standard** – off leash, qualified in Standard B off leash
21. **Agility Course Design** – qualified in Advanced Standard
