- ❖ During judging no discussion from audience about entries until lot has been placed.

## CLASS C - FLOWERS FROM BULBS - Specimens Only

### Lot

1. Lily (Calla) – one bloom
2. Dahlias, small – one bloom
3. Dahlias, large – one bloom
4. Galdiola – 1 stem
1. 7. Daylilies –same variety, 3 flowers, closed buds on stem are OK
2. 8. Oriental Lilies –3 flowers on one or more stem
3. 9. Any other Lily – one variety (Tiger, Asiatic, Trumpet, etc.) – 3 flowers on 1 or more stem. Write NAMED variety on tag.

## CLASS D - ARRANGEMENTS

### Lot

1. Basket of Perennials – NO annuals
2. Salute to Green County – “Just Say Cheese arrangement using flowers in “cheese” colors. Accessories permitted.
3. Green arrangement – including container
4. All white arrangement – including container
5. Flower arrangement for grandma
6. Miniature arrangement – under 6”
7. “Side of the Road” arrangement
8. Arrangement in Red, White & Blue
9. Arrangement for kitchen
10. Arrangement in a junk container
11. Edible arrangement, using fruit and/or vegetables. Foliage and flowers can be used.
12. Hosta leaf arrangement- with or without hosta blooms.
13. Arrangement using all annuals (4 or more)
14. Party in a Tea Cup
15. Biggest bloom- any other flower ( 1 bloom only)

*Plants must be in place by 7:00 p.m Tuesday and remain on exhibition until 6:00 p.m. on Sunday.*

3. Any Begonia (single plant)
4. Any Impatient (single plant)
5. African violet (single plant or double flower)
6. Unusual Blooming Plant- must be labeled
7. Any other flowering plant – labeled on tag
8. Coleus
9. Indoor dish garden – planter (3 or more potted green plants, etc.)
10. Terrarium
11. Outdoor planted container – (3 or more plants potted)
12. Herb Garden, potted (3 or more plants)
13. “Fairy Garden” display.
14. “A Pot of Sole”- any plant(s) grown in a boot or show
15. Ivy (single plant)
16. Christmas or Easter Cactus
17. Succulent dish garden (3 or more plants)
