Rules and Instructions
(Grades K-2 Only)
All Lots Face-to-Face

- a) Exhibitors and their families are responsible for reading and complying with the Junior Fair General Rules & Instructions.
- b) Fair Association is not responsible for articles lost/stolen during fair.
- c) Exhibitors are responsible for securing to the display or exhibit all loose pieces of the entry (i.e. wire, zip ties, string, or glue).
- d) **All models should be mounted on a base or platform no larger than 18"x18"**.
- e) Posters must be no larger than 14"x22" and have a title. Displays must be no larger than 22"x28".
- f) Pictures can be cutouts, drawings, or photos.
- g) Pictures should be glued on to a poster or mat with rubber cement and be labeled.
- h) No real food or live animals are to be exhibited.
- i) Put name, age, club, class, and lot number on back side of every entry.
- j) Participants receive ribbons **ONLY**.
- k) **Members can enter up to 4 lots.**
- l) Projects can be brought in from Noon to 6:30 p.m. on Tuesday. Judging begins at 12 noon and goes until 6:30 pm. All projects will be judged one-on-one individually with the member when they arrive.
- m) Projects are released at 6:00 p.m. on Sunday.

CLASS A – ANIMAL SCIENCE

Lot

1. Create a critter
2. Display or poster about insect(s)
3. Scrapbook or memory book about your pet
4. Any other pet exhibit (no live animals)
5. Bird feeder
6. Bird house

7. Craft that is animal related
8. Any other animal exhibit (No Live Animals)

CLASS B – EXPRESSIVE ARTS

Lot

1. Musical instrument made by exhibitor
2. Scrapbook of photos done by member (with captions/journaling)
3. Puppet made by exhibitor
4. T-shirt decorated by exhibitor (on hanger)
5. Any other wearable art project
6. Small wood item
7. Any craft item
8. Item of art from a kit (i.e. paint by number, scratch art, etc.)

CLASS C – HOME ECONOMICS

Lot

1. Small silk flower arrangement done by exhibitor
2. Display or poster about dairy products
3. Display or poster about the food groups
4. Scrapbook about or 4 pictures of my room
5. Any sewing or stitchery item
6. Craft item for the home (kits can be used)
7. Home décor item (i.e. ceramics)
8. "I want to be a chef!" (Do a display or exhibit about a menu you helped plan).
9. Any other related poster or display not mentioned above

CLASS D – MECHANICAL SCIENCE

Lot

1. Scrapbook or poster of safety in the home
2. First aid kit put together by exhibitor
3. Homemade kite
4. Model of electrical circuit
5. Paper airplane made by exhibitor
6. Snap together model kit
7. K'nex creature or critter
8. Poster or display on any other mechanical science project

CLASS E – NATURAL SCIENCES

Lot

1. Collection of leaf or bark rubbings
2. Nature mobile
3. Craft made of recycled materials
4. Project about trees
5. Poster or display on "How I save water"
6. Going Green Project (exhibit about the environment)
7. Backyard wildlife project
8. Any other natural resources project

CLASS F – PERSONAL GROWTH & DEVELOPMENT

Lot

1. My Family Tree (poster, scrapbook, etc.)
2. Family scrapbook
3. Book or scrapbook all about me
4. Scrapbook or poster about friends
5. Autographs of adult community workers (minimum of 5, maximum of 10; i.e. sales clerks, banker, post office worker, hospital worker, etc.)
6. "My Cloverbud Record Book" (up to the fair)
7. Exhibit about something I did for the first time this year (i.e. swim, skateboard, cook, roller skate, drive go-cart, etc.)
8. Any other related display or poster

CLASS G – PLANTS AND SOIL SCIENCE

Lot

5. Dish garden (uncovered garden of plants)

Lot
