**Photography Rules and Instructions**

- a) Exhibitors and their families are responsible for reading and complying with the Junior Fair General Rules & Instructions.
- b) Fair association is not responsible for articles lost/stolen during fair.
- c) Photography must be the result of the exhibitor's project work. Pictures are to have been taken after the 1st day of the previous fair.
- d) Exhibitors must exhibit in their grade division. Limit of 4 entries per exhibitor and no more than 1 entry per lot number.
- e) Any 1 or 2 picture exhibit (5x7 or smaller photo) must be exhibited on 8"x10" poster. All other exhibits must be on 11"x14" poster board. Securely mount photos with **rubber cement or scrapbooking glue** rather than glue. Poster must be on **white or black poster boards only** – no other colors allowed. No foam core boards or matted boards please. **No titles or captions will be allowed.** List name, club, and type of camera on the bottom back of each poster.
- f) **NO MATTING WILL BE ALLOWED.** No picture frames or hangers. Cropping is encouraged and must be used if the number of required photographs will not fit on the poster board sizes listed above. Cropping is limited to square and rectangular shapes. It is **suggested** that no dates appear on the front of the photograph.
- g) **No borders, outlining or decorating of photos or poster board is allowed – display your photos only.**
- h) You may not exhibit the same photograph in more than one lot number or more than one department.
- i) Photos will be judged on the basis of technical quality, composition, and story-telling ability.

- j) Winning photos entered in the "3 prints promoting tourism in Green County" become the property of the Green County Tourism Committee.
- k) Please try to leave an area for the Exhibitor's tag to be placed at the top left corner of the poster.

## VIDEOGRAPHY

### Rules & Regulations

- a) Open to ALL members enrolled in Videography.
- b) The Fair Association is not responsible for articles lost or stolen during fair.
- c) Video must be the work of the exhibitor. Exhibitors will comply with the copyright regulations and display an image that is appropriate for the 4-H audience.
- d) All video entries in Class E-F must be submitted digitally by July 1, 2021 at:

- a. No time and date should be imprinted on the footage.
- b. All videos should include an opening title screen, as well as closing credits, which include date of production, name of video, exhibitor and research sources if appropriate.
- c. Entries may be black and white, or color, and be original work done during current 4-H year.

- f) Criteria for judging. 1. Evidence of a story line. 2. Use of camera angles. 3. Use of zooming techniques. 4. Smoothness of scene changes. Image and sound quality will be taken into consideration in relation to equipment used/available.

### **CLASS E – VIDEOGRAPHY, Gr. 3-7**
