Woodworking Rules and Instructions

- a) Exhibitors and their families are responsible for reading and complying with the Junior Fair General Rules & Instructions.
- b) The Fair Association is not responsible for articles lost/stolen during fair.
- c) Members must exhibit in the Unit in which they are enrolled, including shop class entries.
- d) Exhibitors must exhibit in their grade division. Limit of 4 entries per exhibitor and no more than 1 entry per lot number.
- e) Work must have been made since the previous county fair.
- f) All articles are to be finished according to their intended use. The quality of the finish will be considered as part of the workmanship in judging.
- g) An article made for class work and for a grade or extra credit must be entered in the class so designated.
- h) No kits or mass production items to be used, except in specified lots.
- i) **Each entry should have a 3"x5" card which describes:**
 - a. **Exhibitor grade and number of years in project**
 - b. **Steps taken to complete this exhibit.**
 - c. **What have you learned or practiced in completing this exhibit.**
- j) Hangable projects must have applicable hangers for their intended use.
- k) Posters must be no larger than 14"x22", and displays must be no larger than 28"x40", unless otherwise stated.
