Photography Rules and Instructions

- a) Read the General Fair Rules & Instructions document!!!
- b) Exhibitors must exhibit in their grade division.
- c) Limit of 5 photography entries per exhibitor and no more than 1 entry per lot number.
- d) See chart for picture to poster size for exhibits. Posters must be black or white.
- e) All photos are to be 4"x6" unless stated otherwise. Enlargements are 5"x7".
- f) Securely mount photos with <u>rubber cement or scrapbooking</u> glue.
- g) No borders or decorations
- h) Attach exhibitor tag on back, center of poster board.
- NO MATTING, FRAMES, or HANGERS.
- j) Cropping is encouraged and must be used if the number of required photographs will not fit on the poster board sizes listed above. Cropping is limited to square and rectangular shapes.
- k) It is <u>suggested</u> that no dates appear on the front of the photograph.
- You may **NOT** exhibit the same photograph in more than one lot number or more than one department.
- m) Photos will be judged on the basis of technical quality, composition, and story-telling ability.

VIDEOGRAPHY

Rules & Regulations

- a) Exhibitors will comply with the copyright regulations and display an image that is appropriate for a vouth audience.
- b) All video entries will be judged in person Face-to-Face. Exhibitor is to bring video and device to play the video on at the time of judging.
- c) Exhibitors must submit their video entry digitally by July 1, 2024 at: https://forms.gle/9WNe1DEdbVq4nyfC6
- d) No time and date should be imprinted on the footage.
- e) Entries may be black and white, or color, and be original work done since the previous Fair.
- f) Exhibitors must exhibit in their grade division. Limit of 2 Videography entries per exhibitor and no more than 1 entry per lot number.
- g) Criteria for judging. 1. Evidence of a story line. 2. Use of camera angles. 3. Use of zooming techniques. 4. Smoothness of scene changes. Image and sound quality will be taken into consideration in relation to equipment used/available.

CLASS E

Lot

- 130. Social Media Story or Reel (30-60 seconds in length)
- 131. Animated Video prepare 2-3 minute video to present creative animation of original artwork created by the exhibitor. Media might include: Claymation, images created with graphics software, or hand drawn images.
- 132. Music Video produce an original work that is 2-3 minutes in length.
- 133. Documentary conduct research based investigation into a topic of choice to produce a documentary that is 3-5 minutes long. Opening Title Screen & Video credits should list research sources and may include paper or electronically published materials, as well as, interviews with experts or constituents.
