Rabbit Rules and Instructions

- 1. Read the General Fair Rules & Instructions document!!
- 2. Read the Animal Health Rules & Regulations document!!
- 3. All junior rabbit exhibitors must be certified in the Youth for the Quality Care of Animals (YQCA) and submit their certification number through FairEntry to exhibit rabbits at the Green County Fair.
- 4. Exhibitors allowed one entry per lot and not more than a total of 5 entries (Class A-I). Showmanship (Class J) can be entered in addition to your 5 entries.
- 5. Rabbits entered in Classes A-H must be registered or non-registered purebred rabbits; no crossbreds (Crossbreds may be shown in Dept. 10 under Pet Rabbits).
- 6. All market single roaster rabbits must be checked in by 4:00 p.m. on Tuesday and will be weighed in at 4:00 p.m. Each exhibitor, or someone standing in for them, is expected to be present for the weigh-in of their rabbit at 4:00 pm. There will be no repeat weighing or swapping out rabbits if they do not make weight.
- 7. Each exhibitor must daily take care of his/her own exhibit(s) and be the only one going into your cage(s).

 Rabbits not taken care of daily (morning, night and additionally, as needed) will be sent home and the member will forfeit the premium money on the exhibit(s) and eligibility to exhibit in this department next year.
- 8. No bedding (hay, straw, grass, etc.) will be allowed in cages.
- 9. Cages will be zip tied after 8:00 pm each night by superintendents.
- 10. Superintendents are allowed to go into cages for the health and well-being of the rabbits.
- 11. Exhibitors must provide a water container that CANNOT be tipped over for each of their pens.
- 12. Rabbits must be handled by the exhibitor during the show.
- 13. Herdsmanship will be based on cleanliness, animal, cage, surrounding area, and educational displays.
- 14. All exhibitors are required to clean their cages after 6:00 PM on Sunday, but prior to leaving the fairgrounds. Rabbits, shavings and decorations must remain in place for display until 6:00pm on Sunday and must be picked up prior to 9 pm. Otherwise the exhibitor will forfeit the premium money on the exhibits and eligibility to exhibit in this department next year.
- 15. Exhibitors are encouraged to bring a carrier for show day. All carriers/boxes must be removed from the rabbit barn after check-in and after the show on Thursday (no exceptions). Empty cages are not to be used for tack/storage.
- 16. No rabbits can be advertised for sale other than Green County Fur & Feather Auction entries.
- 17. Class C Any Other Class 6 Breed (any over 5 lbs.) includes but is not limited to the following breeds: American, Californians, Blanc D'Hoto, Checkered Giant, American Chinchilla, Cinnamon, Creme D'Argent, Champagne D'Argent, Palomino, American Sable, Giant Chinchilla, Silver Fox, Giant Angora, Statin
- 18. Class E Any Other Class 4 Breed (under 5 lbs.) includes but is not limited to the following breeds: *English Angora, French Angora, Standard Chinchilla, Dwarf Hotot, English Spot, Florida White, Himalayan, Jersey Wooly, Lilac, Mini Satin, Rhinelander, Tans, Thiranta, Standard Rex, Silver Martin, Lionheads, Dutch, Havana, Harlequin, American Sable*

CLASS I – MARKET LOTS

Rules and Instructions

- A. Single Roaster Rabbits must be entered in Class I, Lot 80. They must weigh <u>between 5.5 9 lbs. and be under 6 months of age</u> to be eligible for the Fur and Feather Auction.
- B. The Single Roaster lot will be divided if more than 16 rabbits are entered. Roasters will be grouped into lots according to their weigh-in weight. Lot divisions will be posted prior to 5:00 pm Wednesday. Top two roasters in each weight division will compete for Overall Champion and Reserve Roaster Rabbit.
- C. Roasters may not be entered in any other lot or class.

CLASS J – SHOWMANSHIP
