- Must attend the crowning ceremony at the Green County Breakfast on the Farm.
- Be available to commit to attending promotional events.
- Be available for pre-fair events and during the entire week of the Green County Fair.
- Must be 18 years or older as of January 1 in order to compete at the Wisconsin Association of Fairs Convention for the title of Wisconsin Fairest of the Fairs.
- Must be able to attend the Annual meeting (3rd Tuesday in November).
- Be able to attend the Wisconsin Association of Fairs competition in early January.



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DESCRIPTION OF FAIREST CONTEST RULES

Job Objective:

Serve as the official ambassador of the Green County Fair and participate in the promotional programs and media events. Represent the Green County Fair at festivals and other functions for one year. The winner will also compete for the title Wisconsin Fairest of the Fairs at the State Fair Convention in January.

Rules:

- Must have a valid Wisconsin driver's license.
- Must be 18 years or older as of January 1st.
- Must be a resident of Green County.
- Must attend the crowning ceremony at the Green County Breakfast on the Farm.
- Be available to commit to attending promotion events.
- Must be available for pre-fair events and during the entire week of the Green County Fair.
- Must be available to attend the Annual meeting (3rd Tuesday in November).
- Must be able to attend the Wisconsin Association of Fairs competition in January.

Competition:

Judging will consist of individual and group interviews. During competition, each contestant will be asked to present a mock 30 second radio commercial advertising the Green County Fair and then the contestant will answer and impromptu interview questions. The radio commercial should be written by the contestant beforehand. The judges will choose the Green County Fairest of the Fair and an alternate; and they will be announced and crowned at the Green County Breakfast on the Farm.

Contestants will be judged on:

- Personality & Attitude
- Maturity and Professionalism
- Speaking Ability
- Poise & Professional Appearance
- Involvement & Activities
- Overall Impression
