



Home Furnishings Rules and Instructions

- a) **Read the General Rules & Instructions** document!!!
- b) All exhibitors are encouraged to be present for judging.
- c) No more than 6 entries may be made by one exhibitor.
- d) Recommended that entries be accompanied by a 3"x5" card which describes:
 1. Steps taken to complete this exhibit.
 2. How & where this exhibit will be used or displayed in your home (include a description of how this item coordinates with the room/area of the home – i.e. colors, style, function)
- e) Include (secure) hangers if the item is to be hung. Pictures should be framed.
- f) Quilts include tied, hand-quilted, machine quilted professionally or home sewing machine.
- a) All quilted wall hangings should include a picture or description of how they will be used at home. Bring an item with a dowel rod for use in hanging.
- b) Posters can be no larger than 14"x22", and displays can be no larger than 28"x40".
