- ❖ Flower specimens will be judged on size, shape, health and quality; not on container.
- ❖ Arrangements will be judged on condition of materials, color, proportion and balance, and container.

6. Miniature arrangement - under 6"
7. "Side of the Road" arrangement
8. Arrangement in Red, White & Blue
9. Arrangement for kitchen
10. Arrangement in a junk container
11. Edible arrangement, using fruit and/or vegetables. Foliage and flowers can be used.
